<b>RIIWHS202E</b>	Enter and work in confined spaces
<b>RIIWHS204E</b>	Work safely at heights
<b>RIICOM201E</b>	Communicate in the workplace
<b>RIIWHS205E</b>	Control traffic with stop-slow bat
<b>RIIWHS302E</b>	Implement traffic management plans
<b>FBPOPR2074</b>	Carry out manual handling tasks
<b>RIIRTM203E</b>	Work as a safety observer/spotter

## Other information:

### To be eligible participants must be:

- ▶ currently unemployed and registered with a jobactive provider
- ▶ an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident of Australia or a refugee or humanitarian visa holder
- ▶ over 18 years of age
- ▶ able to pass a drug and alcohol and medical assessment
- ▶ a white card holder or willing to obtain one
- ▶ able to travel to the training site and worksite location.
