If you:

- Are aged 15–24 and not attending school
- Haven't worked or studied for the last 4 weeks
- Are working but getting low hours
- Are thinking about leaving school
- Are an Australian citizen or hold a permanent visa, a New Zealand Special Category Visa or a Nominated Visa (including Temporary Protection Visa or Safe Haven Visa)

You may be eligible for our new Workforce Australia Transition to Work Program (TtW).

Centrelink eligibility is not required.

What is TtW?

The TtW employment service is a government funded initiative to help young people find work, apprenticeships, traineeships, education and training opportunities.

Our program will help you:

- Build confidence
- Develop work related skills
- Source education or training opportunities
- Pursue apprenticeship and traineeship roles
- Find work in your local area
- Access relevant community services
